WHAT INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT?

Your personal privacy is important to ARMR. We will not share nor retain any information entered on our website. ARMR does not accept any liability if this report is used for an alternative purpose from which it is intended, nor to any third party in respect to the above text. Users may not use data collected from our website to contact individuals, companies or other persons or entities.

We collect information from you when you register on our site.

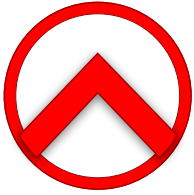
When registering on our site, you may be asked to enter your name, email address, location and other related details. You may however, visit our site without registering. We will send you an email containing your login details and associated login link once you register. It is imperative that you do not share your details with anybody.

We also may retain server logs which include the IP address of every request to our server.

WHAT DO WE USE YOUR INFORMATION FOR?

Any of the information we collect from you may be used in one of the following ways:

- To personalize your experience – your information helps us to better respond to your individual needs.
- To improve our site – we continually strive to improve our site offerings based on the information and feedback we receive from you.
- To improve our service – your information helps us to more effectively respond to your needs.
- To send periodic emails – the email address you provide may be used to send you information, notifications that you request about changes to topics or in response to your user name, respond to inquiries, and/or other requests or questions.



HOW DO WE PROTECT YOUR INFORMATION?

We implement a variety of security measures to maintain the safety of your personal information when you enter, submit or access your personal information.

WHAT IS YOUR DATA RETENTION POLICY?

We will make a good faith effort to:

- Retain server logs containing the IP address of all requests to this server for no more than 90 days.
- Retain the IP addresses associated with registered users and their posts for no more than 5 days.

DO WE USE COOKIES?

Yes. Cookies are small files that a site or its service provider transfers to your computer's hard drive through your web browser (if you allow). These cookies enable the site to recognize your browser and, if you have a registered account, associate it with your registered account.

We use cookies to understand and save your preferences for future visits and compile aggregate data about site traffic and site interaction so that we can offer better site experiences and tools in the future. We may contract with third-party service providers to assist us in better understanding our site visitors. These service providers are not permitted to use the information collected on our behalf except to help us conduct and improve our business.

OUTSIDE THIRD PARTY DISCLOSURE

We do not sell, trade or otherwise transfer your personally identifiable information to outside parties. This does not include trusted third parties who assist us in operating our site, conducting our business, or servicing you, so long as those parties agree to keep this information confidential. We may also release your information when we believe release is appropriate to comply with the law, enforce our site policies, or protect ours or others rights, property, or safety. However, non-personally identifiable visitor information may be provided to other parties for marketing, advertising or other uses.

THIRD PARTY LINKS

We use third party sites only to help our users fully complete and engage with our website business. Other than that we will not use third-party sites for any reason.

YOUR RIGHTS
